



Sable is in demand on the international fur market what is confirmed by participation of more buyers and their high activity in the January auction compared to the previous auctions.

At the auction there were offered 324 thousand of wild sable skins, that exceeded by 20 percent the offers at the auctions of the last years. The most active buyers were Greek, Italian and Hong Kong firms. Prices for regular skins decreased by 20 percent, prices for silvery skins remained at the level of the April 2017 auction.

Giving the recent market conditions the result of the January auction was satisfactory.

The top lot of wild sable was bought by **TSOUKAS BROS AND SONS S.A., Kastoria, Greece**.
